During class today, the group that went to Lithuania this summer will report on their trip. Please come and hear about the trip and what God did through the CVCC members.

When this congregation was founded in 1983, the members felt it was important to identify the core of Connecticut Valley's identity. After much conversation and prayer, the group compiled a list of *four undeniabes*. There was no intention to reduce these four items to the only identifiable characteristics of Christians or members of CVCC, but these defined the core beliefs of the church. In a world where there are infinite choices to define one's belief in God and thus, one's view of God's people, these four undeniabes ground our congregation in our relationship to God and our connection to God's people. During the month of September, we will explore these four beliefs that should still define CVCC as a people of God.

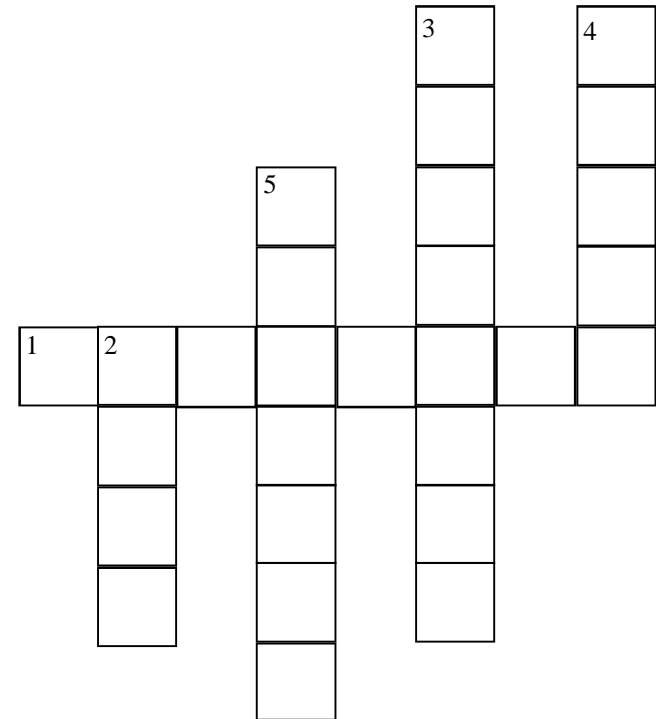
