I will be living in the community house on Vine Street from May 31 to August 8 and will be able to experience life with a diverse family of believers for those ten weeks.

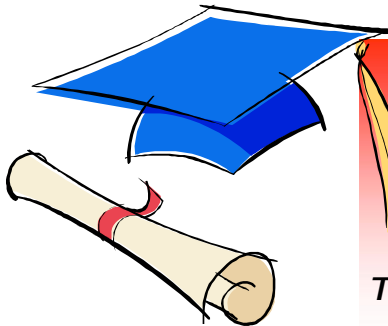
